All documentation must be submitted with the application in order to be considered.

Additional Expenses

- Meals up to \$60 a day
- Travel other than by car
- Photocopying/archival retrieval
- Activities necessary to complete the project/research

Membership fees
Subscriptions to journals

Maximum Award

• \$2000 per person for the year

No more than 100% of the activity from all sources

• Funding depends on the total number of applicants
